ADRIAN HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure the safety and well-being of those students who participate in the AHS Band camp, these guidelines will be followed at all times. To attend camp each student must have this form on file.

- 1. **DRUGS/ALCOHOL:** Possession of either any controlled or uncontrolled substances will result in the child being sent home. This includes prescription or non-prescription medications, cigarettes, vape, e-cigarettes, marijuana, etc. A camp refund is not given back as the entire camp week has already been paid for.
- 2. *UNAUTHORIZED LEAVING OF CAMP:* All campers will remain in the designated band camp area for the duration of camp. Daily this includes 8 am to 8 pm.
- 3. *FIREWORKS/FIREARMS/WEAPONS*: Campers will not have in their possession any form of firework(s), firearm(s) or weapon(s). This includes knives small and large, swords, guns, etc.
- 4. *FIGHTING/BULLYING:* Campers are to work to become one united marching band or family. Fighting, hazing, bullying, name-calling, or any other aggressive behavior will result in disciplinary action which may lead to suspension from camp. This is not allowed at our school. If you see it Speak Up,
- 5. **SEXUALLY INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:** The band is here to learn. Physical forms of expression are inappropriate at this camp. This means no public displays of affection. Including: holding hands, sitting on each other's lap, kissing, etc.
- 6. **SNEAKING OFF:** Campers are to remain in designated areas during camp hours. There will be other students at the school for sports-related activities. Our time at camp is to learn music and drill.
- 7. *TRESPASSING/VANDALISM:* We will leave the camp areas better than we found it. Be Respectful.
- 8. **SWIMMING:** Appropriate Swimwear must be worn at all times when in the water. Be respectful of others and the lifeguards on duty. No "horseplay" in the water such as dunking or getting on their shoulders.
- 9. *MODESTY:* Campers should use the highest level of discretion when it comes to camp dress. Campers should choose clothing that covers the body and keeps the band member comfortable. If clothing is deemed inappropriate or revealing campers will be required to change. Underclothing should be covered.
- 10. **BEHAVIOR:** Campers should reflect modest behavior in their personal interactions while respecting those around them. This includes fellow students as well as adults such as camp coaches, parent chaperones, adult helpers, teachers, custodial staff, and other students not in the band.

POSSIBLE RESPONSES TO INFRACTIONS OF THE CODE:

Minor infractions will result in a consequence including but not limited to a warning, removal of contraband material, and/or a phone call to guardians.

Severe infractions will result in the camper being sent home, with no refund, at the expense of the guardian.

All infractions will be reported to AHS administration per the APS Student Code of Conduct.
