



ADRIAN HIGH SCHOOL BAND CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

To insure the safety and well-being of those students who participate in the AHS Band camp, these guidelines will be followed at all times. In order to attend camp each student must have this form on file.

1. **DRUGS/ALCOHOL:** Possession of either of these substances will result in the child being sent home. This includes non-disclosed prescription or non-prescription medications found on the child.
2. **UNAUTHORIZED LEAVING OF CAMP:** All campers will remain in the campground area.
3. **FIREWORKS/FIREARMS/WEAPONS:** Campers will not have in their possession any form of firework(s), firearm(s) or weapon(s).
4. **FIGHTING/BULLYING:** Campers are to work to become one united marching band, or family. Fighting, hazing, bullying, or any other aggressive behavior will result in disciplinary action which may lead to suspension from camp.
5. **SEXUALLY INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:** The band is here to learn. Physical forms of expression are inappropriate at this camp.
6. **SNEAKING OUT: (Lights out time will be designated by the director's at the end of evening rehearsal)** Campers are to remain in their cabin at night.
7. **TRESPASSING/VANDALISM:** We will leave the camp better than we found it.
8. **UNAUTHORIZED SWIMMING:** There is no lifeguard on duty. Due to school policy students are not allowed to swim without appropriate supervision.
9. **MODESTY:** Campers should use the HIGHEST level of discretion when it comes to camp dress. Campers should choose dress that covers the body and keeps the band member comfortable. Questionable clothing should be left at home. Athletic shoes are mandatory at outdoor rehearsals.
10. **BEHAVIOR:** Campers should reflect modest behavior in their personal interactions while respecting those around them.

POSSIBLE RESPONSES TO INFRACTIONS OF THE CODE:

Minor infractions will be dealt with at the discretion of the Band Director.

Severe infractions will require the students being sent home and will be dealt with according to school board policy.
